IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. Except as set forth in the Settlement Agreement and the Final Approval Order, Plaintiffs and the Settlement Class Members shall take nothing by the Complaint in this action. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Jessica Fonseca is excluded from the Settlement Class and shall not be bound by the Settlement Agreement or the Amended Judgment.
2. The Settlement Agreement provided that Defendant Pride Bakeries, LLC fund the total settlement amount of \$50,000. Defendant did so on May 15, 2014.

1           3.     As set forth in the Supplemental Declaration of Tina Chiango filed with the Court  
2 on October 30, 2014, the settlement funds were distributed as follows:

- 3           a.     On May 29, 2014, the Court-approved claims administrator mailed 455 checks to  
4           the Settlement Class Members and mailed an additional check for \$1,500 to  
5           Plaintiff, representing the Court-approved Service Payment.  
6           b.     On May 29, 2014, the claims administrator mailed a check for \$3,750 to the  
7           California Labor & Workforce Development agency, representing the Court-  
8           approved PAGA payment to the State of California.  
9           c.     On May 29, 2014, the claims administrator paid itself the Court-approved amount  
10           of \$5,000, for services rendered in this action.  
11           d.     On May 30, 2014, the claims administrator wired \$17,500 to Plaintiff's counsel,  
12           comprising the Court-approved Fee and Expense Award.

13           4.     After the check stale date of September 24, 2014 passed, there was a total of  
14 \$3,391.92 in unclaimed settlement funds. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement and Code of  
15 Civil Procedure section 384, on October 23, 2014, the unpaid settlement funds of \$3,391.27 were  
16 paid to the named and Court-approved cy pres beneficiary, the Legal Aid Society of Orange  
17 County & Community Legal Services of Southeast Los Angeles County on October 23, 2014.

18           5.     Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Code of Civil Procedure Section 664.6, and  
19 Rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of Court, this Court retains jurisdiction over Plaintiff, all  
20 Settlement Class Members, and Defendant to enforce the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the  
21 Final Approval Order, and this Judgment.
